The Park gets its share of stray and abandoned pets. Concerned residents might like to know

about Animal Trustees of Austin (ATA) for their own pets or to help the strays.

ATA has very affordable prices for neutering, spaying, shots, flea prevention and other services.

They are located at 5129 Cameron Road.

Spay & Neuter Clinic – 450-0111

Services provided by appointment only
Wed. through Sat. from 7:30 AM to 6:00 PM

Cats: Neuter--\$20 Spay--\$25
Dogs: Neuter--\$30 Spay--\$35

Wellness Clinic – 451-9355

Services provided on a walk-in basis
Sat. - 9 A M to 6 PM Sun. – 12 Noon to 4 PM
Mon. through Wed. – 12:30 to 7:30

Exam fee: \$7 per animal
Vaccinations run from \$6 for rabies, up to \$15 for Feline FVRCP-C/FELV.

ATA also sells major brands of flea prevention from \$9 to \$13.50, depending on animal's size, for single treatment and from \$36 to \$42 for a 4-pack. There is a 3-pack available from \$30 to \$40, also depending on pet's size.

De-worming - \$8 to \$10

Heartworm Prevention - \$2.50-\$3.50 for single doses and \$15 to \$21 for 6-packs.

ATA's hours and prices make it easy to give any dog or cat the care they deserve.
