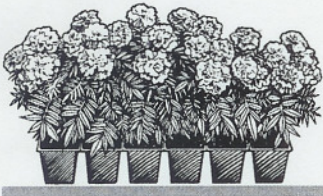

Swimming Pool – Please Read!

Pool Keys

The cylinders for the new pool locks have been on backorder but were replaced on Thursday, 5 April. Your old keys will no longer work.
New key deposit - \$15

The pool has been open this season since 9 March. Since then, residents have been seen swimming in regular everyday clothes. Before the pool season is in full swing, we wanted to take a moment to remind everyone of the pool rules, and while all rules are important, the following are the six rules that are most often *not* being observed:

- Swimsuits and swim trunks only are permitted for swimming. No cutoffs, shorts or street clothes allowed in the pool. No swimming in undergarments is allowed. No "skinny dipping" is allowed. Light colored t-shirts are only permitted over swimsuits for protection from the sun.
- Disposable and cloth diapers must have some type of plastic covering worn over them to prevent the diapers from coming apart in the pool.
- Children 12 years old and under must have adult supervision (someone 18 years or older) at all times.
- No diving, running, loud noises, or loud music are permitted.
- No bicycles, skateboards, roller blades/skates, etc. are allowed in the pool area at any time.
- After 8:30 pm the pool is reserved for the exclusive use of persons 18 years and older (i.e. lap swimming, water aerobic activity, etc.)

A full list of the pool rules are posted at the pool and on the Park's website by going to www.pqchoa.com, then go "Policies & Procedures" and then select policy #12. Should any of pool rules not be followed, you and/or your guest(s) may be asked to leave the pool area. Also, please remember that there is **NO lifeguard on duty at anytime; swim at your own risk!**
